Kayak and Paddleboard Skyline Tour on Lady Bird Lake

Lady Bird Lake, or Town Lake as some locals still call it (even though it's not a lake, but a dammed part of the Lower Colorado River), is home to some of Austin's landmarks and architectural points of interest. Participants will see the city from a new perspective on paddleboards or kayaks, while learning a bit about Austin's history, popular Austin sites, and the famous Congress Avenue Bridge Bats.
