#### Fly Fishing – Offered Thursday

12:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m., \$500/person

Try one of Utah's most popular summer activities—fly-fishing! A professional guide will outfit anglers with all the necessary equipment for a fun half-day wade fishing trip. Wade fishing takes you directly into a stream, river, or lake to cast your fly, outfitted in waders and boots. Regardless of your skill level, these trophy-class, blue ribbon waters promise a day you will always remember.



#### Rafting The Weber River – Offered Thursday

12:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m., \$250/person

Enjoy a rafting trip down the Weber River. The Weber River is surrounded on either side by beautiful trees, beaver ponds, and private farms with horses. Lucky guests might even spot weasels and beavers. A few Class II whitewater rapids add a bit of excitement, yet there are plenty of calmer areas, allowing guests to jump in and swim in the cool water.



#### Wasatch Mountain RZR (ATV Tour) – Offered Thursday

Experience the ultimate Park City off-road experience in a Side-by-Side Razor. Guests trade off in the driver's seat as they explore the scenic Weber Canyon. These off-road vehicles are easy to operate with fully automatic transmissions. Just press the gas pedal, and you're off to an unforgettable experience. Professional, friendly guides will provide a thorough operational orientation and then lead you through some of the most incredible backcountry that northern Utah has to offer.



#### History & Whiskey Walking Tour - Offered Thursday/Friday

This activity is approximately 2.5 hours in length. Attendees will learn about Utah's distillation history from the mid-1800s to present day. This is both an indoor and outdoor experience. After the tasting and discussion of the stories behind the local whiskeys, we return outside to finish the tour with an insider's view of how the town was designed, and the location of the first tavern in the red light district.
